Happy February to all TCARA Members and friends of the Club!

We are in an exciting time as a Club, our website is growing, our membership roster is growing and the number of people participating in our Zoom at Noon weekly meeting and our weekly net is also growing! It is a wonderful time for Tri-County Amateur Radio Association.

Our membership recently voted to provide the Net Control Operator of the Club an ICOM IC-2730 radio. In use since January 24th, this is a dual band VHF/UHF mobile radio to be used as a fixed station. Jerry Grzelak, KG6MN has available a **2 meter (144MHz) two element cubical quad** antenna available to any interested ham at no charge. If you are interested, contact Jerry at <a href="jerrygkg6mn@hotmail.com">jerrygkg6mn@hotmail.com</a> for more information.

Dave Wilkie, K6EV is offering an LDG-AT200 Pro II 200 W Automatic HF Antenna Tuner. Comes with supplied accessories as well as an ICOM compatible IC-PAC-6 interface cable for ICOM radios such as the IC-7300 and IC-7610, etc. HRO sells cables for Yaesu such as the 991A. Purchased new at HRO in mid-June 2020 and lightly used for a few months. Able to handle the full 100W output of a transceiver even in 100% duty cycle modes such as FT8 or RTTY (unlike the LDG AT100 Pro II which should probably be limited to about 35W for digital modes). LDG's website shows a transferable 2-year warranty (so covered till mid 2022?). The original purchase receipt and box are included. That said, at this price, no returns and no shipping. Local sale to TCARA and/or GOTAhams club members only. \$160 firm. These are about \$240 new and the cable would be a further \$13. Selling as I added a linear amplfier and moved to the use of a manual antenna tuner which is rated at 2KW power. If interested or if you have questions, contact Dave at d33wilkie@gmail.com

Dave Wilkie K6EV also has an **LDG-AT100 Pro II 100W Automatic HF Antenna tuner**, purchased new in December 2019 and also with an IC-PAC-6 ICOM cable, box, manual, receipt. \$125 firm, no returns, local only, club members only. Still in warranty? This one is extra nice for battery operation as its 'latching' type relays only draw power while switching. Upgraded to AT200 for FT8, but then added the amplifier. - I. Call to Order 7:02PM
- II. Approval of Minutes of General Meeting of Dec 9, 2020 as sent via QRM by general acclamation.
- III. Treasurer's Report Outgoing Treasurer Kurt Dodge, Incoming Ken Barto. Net funds on hand \$5,008.79. One check for \$25.00 outstanding (raffle prize).
- IV. Secretary's Report Dave Wilkie. 42 Renewals as of Jan 1, probably more in PO Box. Request for inputs for QRM February issue.
- V. Program Director Vacancy Filled: Tim Adams, N6DLC appointed to vacancy by board per bylaws. Solicitation of program material and presenter-volunteers made by time Tim. Contact Tim with requests or ideas.
- VI. Publicity Report Ken Mixon: Evolution of website over past 30 days. Thanks to Ken and other volunteers for their contributions and to Tim Adams who is now generously hosting the site and providing many of its technology underpinnings as a donation to the club via his web hosting service. Tcaraclub.net. George Cox plans to talk to Tim and Ken about adding HTML hooks to improve search engine visibility.

Expecting Discussion of locations, contingency plans for pandemic and the setup considerations. Kurt will HAVE TO HAVE VOLUNTEERS and Captains for different tasks. Working sessions? On this subject, Ken mentioned that a silent key page was being added to the site and Brad requested that this would be so, to commemorate those that have passed. Reminder of the passing of Chris Peterson WD6CLT last year.

- f. General Announcements: Hamvention 2021 cancelled due to pandemic. But registrations underway at qsotodayhamexpo.com for virtual hamfest on Mach 13, 14. Discounted admission for pre-registration. Brad reminded us that HAM-CON in the LA area would not occur in 2021 as venues have become prohibitively expensive, as well as for pandemic reasons. It is doubtful that HAM-CON will return to L.A. in its previous form. For TCARA, a reminder that Club meetings are at 7PM not 7:30 going forward. Sunday night nets are now on WA6FZH San Dimas at 446.400 (-) PL 103.5. Members were reminded to join us for Zoom at Noon every Saturday at Noon! And don't forget the nightly nets with our sister club GOTAhams every night at 8.
- VIII. Member questions/ideas round-table: Marida moved and Grace Seconded a motion that the club purchases a mobile radio that the club net operator could use to conduct the weekly club net on Sundays. The ICOM-2730 was proposed with a cost between \$250 and \$300 dollars. The vote was carried unanimously. Also, a subject for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Century committee was raised by Marida: The value of the ARRL Audio news, or some means of adjusting its use to better encourage conversations between members during the club nets. It was observed that the old method of roll call and the news was not very engaging and a number of participants had dropped out. Dave committed that the committee will take add this to the list of things to consider and will see if we can have our cake and eat it too somehow by both providing news and information but ensuring engaging nets.

## TCARA Board Meeting Minutes – January 27, 2021, 7PM

- Call to Order 7:01PM. Bruce Bolton, Ken Mixon, Dave Wilkie, Tim Adams, Brad Rachielles, Doug Barcon attended.
- II. January 6 board minutes approved by general acclamation.
- III. Secretary's Report
  - a. QRM: Few inputs from membership. Brad indicated that previously there was a dedicated editor who spent time digging materials up, but often the frequency of publication was significantly reduced. Dave indicated that he felt reliable publication was important with or without abundant input.
  - b. Board discussed a member inquiry about a specific online SDR class. Unknown teacher, for fee class, out of date hardware of limited add on use. Board did not endorse as it may be a weak value.
  - c. Roster: 45 paid members plus 3 unpaid licensed family members. 48 active members as of Jan 26 2021.
  - d. Little response yet to requests for archive materials. Dave is approaching individuals as time permits.
  - e. Information updates to ARRL HQ for 2021. LA Section info updates. Still pending.
  - f. Responding to inquiry from two returning hams. Suggestion that 2<sup>nd</sup> Century committee explore improved outreach methods and materials. Actively continuing 1:1 Elmering activity for several hams.
  - g. Jay Jones membership now recorded as paid thru 2025 on roster. CLOSED.
- IV. Treasurer's Report –No report or update.
- V. Programs Report Tim Adams: February meeting main topics tentatively Ken's report on QuartzPause and kickoff of Field Day 2021 planning by Kurt with solicitation of lead volunteers for key positions.
- VI. Publicity/Website report Ken Mixon. Updates posted on winter field day. Materials on QuartzPause. Completing membership badges. Will update news on changing hamfest scene and virtual hamfests. Suggestion by Doug Barcon to add former member Wa8lmf.net by Stephen Smith as a possible web link training resource and Tim will explore Stephen as a possible presenter. No longer lives in area.

#### VII. Old Business


### Field Day:
